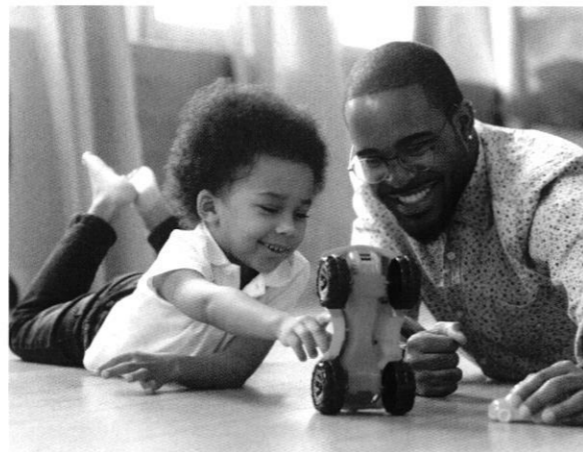




BECOME A CHILD CARE professional

The FCC Program will assist you in seeking the Child Development Associate Credential and Accreditation through the National Association for Family Child Care.

The best thing is your credentials follow you wherever you go, making your home-based business portable. When you PCS or when your spouse leaves the military, you can move your business along with your family.



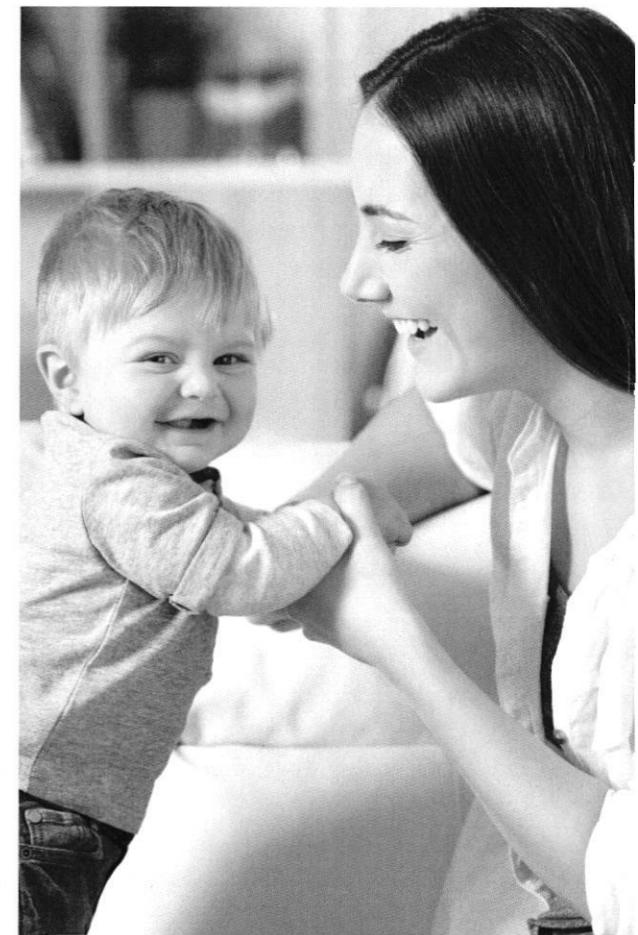
DO YOU LIVE off-base?

MAKE A *difference*

At minimal start-up cost to you, you can operate your own home-based business, set your own hours, be with your children and care for other children at home — with USAF Family Child Care (FCC) programs on 80 installations worldwide or in your civilian community.

The FCC staff will train and help you provide responsible and safe in-home care for children ages 2 weeks to 13 years in your government home or affiliated off-base home.

This is far from a simple baby-sitting service, the FCC Program is looking for individuals who wish to be child care professionals. You must be 18 years of age or older, able to read and speak English, have a high school diploma or GED, in good mental and physical health, able to obtain required insurance and willing to undergo a comprehensive background check. After you complete a basic orientation program, you can set your own hours and fees and begin to care for children on an hourly, part-time, full-time or extended basis.



THE *tools* YOU NEED

The FCC Program makes it easy for you to nurture and care for children in the friendly, warm environment of your own home. We offer an extensive, free equipment and supply a resource center that provides you with everything you need, from forms to outdoor play equipment. The resource center also includes a wide range of child development and safety items such as books, games, toys, safety gates, first-aid kits, electrical outlet covers, pack-n-plays, high chairs, strollers, outdoor play equipment and general supplies.
