When an Airman or Guardian PCSs/ PCAs from a PDS in one State to a PDS in another State, or when returning from overseas to the U.S. and his/her spouse has to reapply for the qualifying occupational state license in the new state, the Department of the Air Force will reimburse the cost of relicensing fees up to \$1000.
